Activation of herpes virus infection*	1 mg 3 times a day, sublingual, for 10 days	3 mg

Indications for Use	Method of Administration	Dosage (daily)
Acute and chronic purulent inflammatory skin and soft tissue infections, severe forms, including purulent septic postsurgical complications	10 mg once a day, for 10 days	10 mg
Sexually transmitted infections (papillomavirus infection, chronic trichomoniasis)	10 mg once a day, for 10 days	10 mg
Pulmonary tuberculosis	10 mg once a day, for 10 days	10 mg
Activation of herpes virus infection (moderate and severe forms)***	10 mg once a day, for 6 days	10 mg
Herpetic eye disease (ophthalmic herpes)	10 mg 2 times a day for 3 days and repeat the course of treatment after a 3-day break interval	20 mg
Psoriasis (excluding psoriatic arthritis, severe forms and gross lesions)	10-20 mg once a day for 10 days followed by 5 doses that should be administered as a 10-20 mg dose taken once every other day.	10-20 mg

For the elderly patients, it is recommended to start therapy with the half doses (1/2 of the therapeutic dose) and to increase the dose of the drug up to the required therapeutic dose if no side effects occur.
